## MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER/ ROLL CALL. President Kathy Stolzmann called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM on May 31, 2017 at Lakeshore Technical College, 1290 North Avenue, Cleveland, Wisconsin.

II. PRESENTATION ON STREET MAINTENANCE OPTIONS AND REVIEW OF SLURRY SEAL AND SEALER BINDER PROPOSAL: FAHRNER ASPHALT SEALERS. Mr. Bill Glatz from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers gave a presentation to the board including an overview of the company and reviewed two options for sealing roads.

GSB 88 works better on roads with a higher rating, can be driven on 2 hours after application, lasts 3-5 years and they have had success using this product for 6 years. It is also a more cost effective way to add life to a newer road surface.

Slurry seal is another option. This product works better on older roads with a lower rating, can last 6-8 years, roads need to be closed for 3-4 hours to allow it to set. Is about double the cost of GSB 88.

III. POSSIBLE ACTION ON PROPOSAL OR REFERRAL FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION. The board discussed several options to maximize the current budget dollars that remain for 2017 and looked at future road sealing projects to budget for 2018. <u>Motion Andy Williams/Nick Jaeger to seal Westview St from W. Washington to Meadowbrook Dr., W. Grant Ave. and Franklin St. using GSB 88 product per price quote from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers for a total of \$15,857; carried without negative vote.</u>

Board discussed budget items for 2018 including a possible \$8,000 for crack filling, GSB 88 Sealer Binder on Westview St. from S. Cleveland to W. Washington Ave. (current estimate \$11,730) along with Slurry Sealing either Hickory St or W. Madison (approx. cost around \$6,500 for one of the roads). The board will discuss these road maintenance projects in further detail as part of the budget discussion.

IV. ADJOURNMENT. Motion Bob Fink/Joel Roehrig to adjourn at 8:26 PM, motion carried without negative vote.
