Village Trustee Nick Jaeger has announced he will vacate his position, effective March 1, 2018.

The Village Board is accepting letters of interest from eligible citizens to complete Trustee Jaeger's term of office, which ends April 15, 2019.

To be eligible, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be a resident of the Village of Cleveland at the time of appointment, and for the immediately preceding 10 days.
2. Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
3. Must be 18 years of age or older.
4. Cannot be a convicted felon still on probation or parole. (A convicted felon who has completed his or her sentence is eligible to serve.)
5. Cannot be an employee of the Village of Cleveland at the time of appointment.

An interested party must submit a letter to the Village Board with his or her name, address, email address, and telephone number. The letter should provide a summary of the candidate's personal and work history, and the reasons the candidate is interested in serving on the Village Board. Additional information can be provided at the candidate's discretion.
