NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
20-YEAR COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE**

The Village Board of Cleveland will hold a public hearing on the proposed adoption of the *Village of Cleveland 20-Year Comprehensive Plan Update* at its 6:00pm meeting on September 17, 2019, at the Cleveland Village Hall, 1150 W. Washington Ave. After the public hearing, the Village Board may adopt the *Village of Cleveland 20-Year Comprehensive Plan* with or without amendment.

An open house informational meeting will precede the Village Board meeting at the Village Hall from 5:30pm to 6pm. Interested individuals can review the update and ask questions about the differences between the proposed and existing comprehensive plans.

The Cleveland Plan Commission, with assistance from the Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission, developed the proposed plan update to describe how the Village envisions its development and the preservation of land in its planning area through the next 20 years. The update addresses the Village's goals, objectives, and land use recommendations; modifies the Future Land Use Map; and revises inventory and analyses of physical setting, demographics, housing, community facilities, transportation facilities, and land uses.
