II. CITIZEN INPUT AND COMMUNICATIONS. No one was present to offer input; no communications were reported.

III. BID AWARD FOR 2020 STREET AND UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS

W. Jefferson Ave. Reconstruction
Park Ct. Rehabilitation
Park Ln. Reconstruction
Linden Bridge Utility Relocation
Lakeshore Dr. Storm Sewer Replacement

Engineer Rammer reported the Village received five bids within \$40,000 of each other. He noted the following:

The target was to complete Village utility work at the bridge by May 1 and natural gas utility work by June 1, so bridge reconstruction could start after that date.

In response to questions from the Board, he noted that smaller quantities of materials generally have a higher price and sometimes contractors build their revenues in other areas of the bid; but he could not explain why the per-foot sanitary pipe price varied so greatly from the estimate.

Recent lower oil prices take longer to come into effect due to processing time. This was unlikely to bring lower prices this year.

Motion Wilmot/Williams to award the bid for the 2020 Street and Utility Improvements to Buteyn-Peterson at a bid price of \$434,768.65; carried without negative vote.

IV. ADJOURNMENT. Motion Holzwart/Berdyck to adjourn; carried without negative vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:08pm.
