RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-18

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT WARD PLAN AND
TO COMBINE WARDS FOR VOTING PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. §5.15, requires all cities, villages, and towns with a population of 1,000 or more to establish municipal wards based on the results of the decennial census; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. §59.10(3)(b) requires that each county board adopt and transmit to each municipal governing body in the county a tentative county supervisory district plan, dividing the county into districts and designating the approximate location and population of each ward proposed to divide the county into districts; and

WHEREAS, the Manitowoc County Board of Supervisors has submitted such a tentative Manitowoc County Supervisory District Plan to the Village of Cleveland, and the Village of Cleveland has received the tentative plan; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Statutes require that each municipality designate by consecutive whole number, geographical description, and population the various wards to be created within the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Cleveland adopts the wards described as follows:


<u>Ward Number</u>	<u>Description of Ward</u>	<u>Population</u>	<u>Polling Place</u>

2	Refer to Attached	592	Village Hall

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Wards 1 and 2 are combined for voting purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the designated polling place for Wards 1 and 2 is at the Cleveland Village Hall, 1150 W. Washington Ave., Cleveland, Wisconsin.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage, a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the village clerk, who shall transmit a copy of the ward plan and this resolution to the County Clerk within five days of its adoption, and that this resolution shall remain in effect for each election until modified or rescinded in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes or until a new division is made following the next federal decennial census.

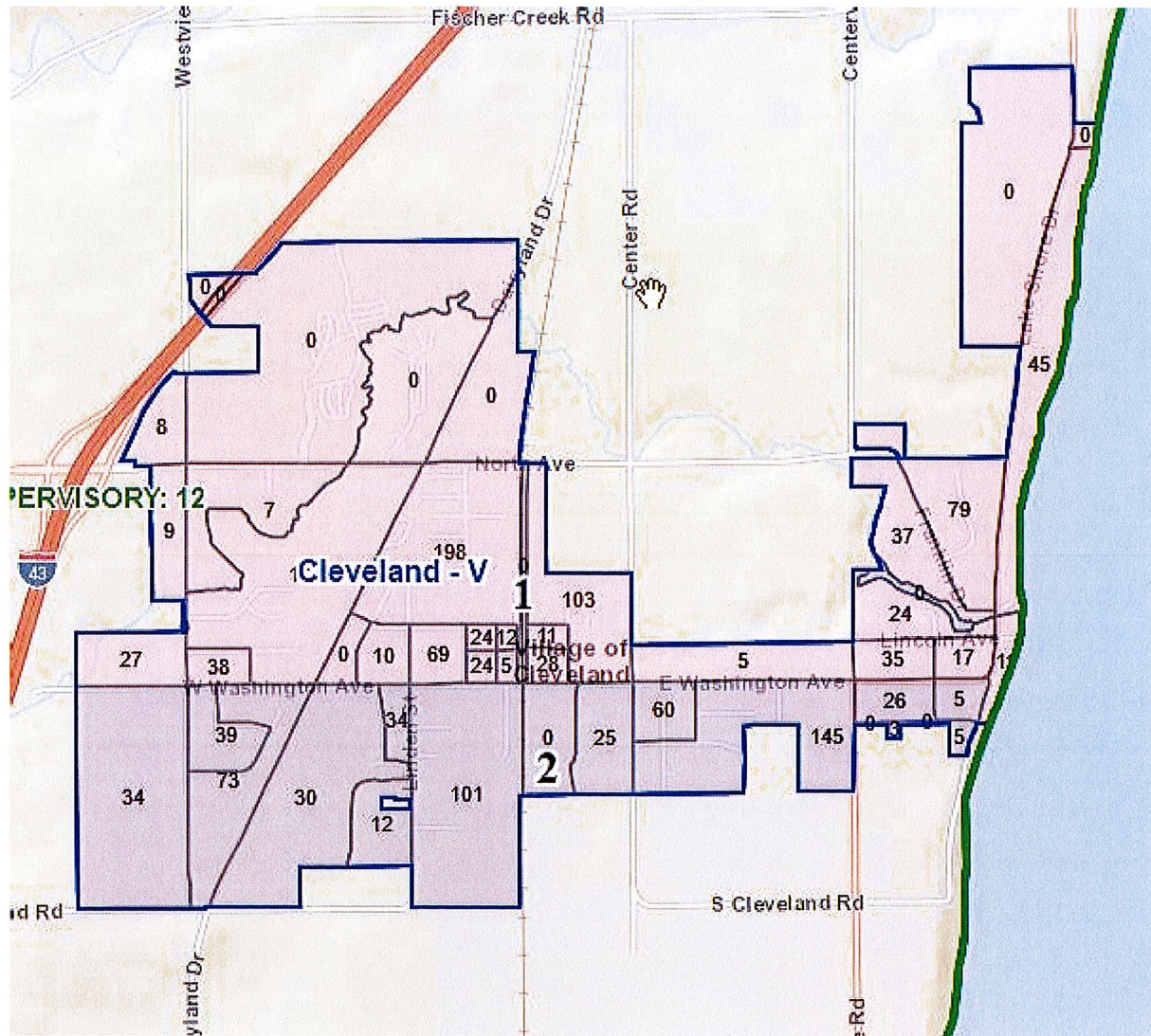
