MININ	MUM FENCE REQUIREMENT	ΓS					
1.	No fence or portion of a fence shall be constructed within the front yard of a building unless it is a decorative fence. A decorative fence cannot exceed a height of 36 inches from ground level; cannot be made of wire, metal, chain or poured concrete; and shall be constructed in a substantially open pattern (such as a weave or board-and-space pattern) and not a solid pattern (such as a block, concrete, or a privacy pattern).						
2.	Fences are permitted on the property lines in all districts, except a fence in the front yard can be no closer than two feet to any public right-of-way. Fences cannot encroach into the public right-of-way or neighboring properties.						
3.	Residential fences shall not exceed a height of six feet in the side and rear yards. Security fences are not allowed in residential districts, shall not exceed ten feet in height, and shall be of an open type similar to woven wire or wrought iron fencing.						
4.	No fence shall be constructed which is a picket fence or which is of an otherwise dangerous condition, or which conducts electricity or is designed to electrically shock or which uses barbed wire; provided, however, that barbed wire may be used in industrially-zoned areas if the devices securing the barbed wire to the fence are ten						

5. All fences shall be maintained and kept safe and in a state of good repair, and the finished side or decorative side of a fence shall face adjoining property. Fences shall be maintained to preserve the required vision clearance at driveways and intersections. Fences in easement areas will be removed by the property owner or at the owner's expense.
