GARBAGE PICKUP

Garbage and recycling pickup should follow the current schedule throughout the project, but if you have questions during construction, contact GFL Environmental at (920) 687-2631 or ChiltonWI@gflenv.com.

LAWN CARE

Property owners are responsible for all watering and maintenance of restored lawn areas. Weeds typically establish earlier than grass; however, with consistent mowing weeds will die off and grass will predominate. The grass should not be cut until it is consistently 4-6 inches tall throughout the lawn area and mowed at the highest setting on a lawn lower.

Property owners are reminded to start watering the lawn seed shortly after it has been placed. Adequate water is essential to establish a root system and a lush green yard.



MAIL SERVICES

Mail services should remain normal. You will be notified If there is a change, such as installation of a temporary mailbox bank. Mailboxes will be installed in the proper location per USPS standards at the end of the project.

PROJECT COMPLETION

Street construction causes a significant inconvenience to you, as a property owner, and there will be times during construction that your driveway will be inaccessible.

With that in mind, we will make all efforts to complete the project by the anticipated completion date, with lawn seeding to be completed soon after.

Completion of the project is based upon weather conditions and the delivery of construction materials through the duration of the project.



The contractor for this project will have various subcontractors working for them throughout project completion.

This project will be supervised by MSA Professional Services; there will be an onsite representative on the job each day during construction to answer any questions regarding the project.

RIGHT-OF-WAY TREES, LANDSCAPING



During construction, there is the possibility for your private property area to be affected by the utility and/or roadway construction process. Any private property area affected by construction will be restored.

The contractor will remove and/or trim existing trees and shrubs that conflict with the construction. An attempt will be made to contact the property owner prior to tree removal. Every effort will be made to protect existing trees that do not interfere with construction.

Property owners planning to transplant trees or save existing fences, decorative stones, inground pet fencing, sprinkler systems, landscaping, or other materials located in the Village right-of-way must move these prior to the start of construction.

The contractor and the Village cannot guarantee the condition of these items once construction begins.

DRIVEWAYS

New driveway approaches will be constructed to the size and material as existing driveways, except gravel driveways which must be upgraded to an impervious surface. If you would like to request a wider driveway approach, contact the Project Engineer as soon as possible.

To reduce the risk of cracking the Village recommends that you do not drive on your new concrete driveway or curb & gutter for a minimum of seven (7) days, after the driveway is poured.

UTILITY LOCATES

Before digging occurs, USIC (diggers hotline) and the Village will mark the underground utilities with spray paint and flags. We ask that property owners do not remove locate flags to prevent utility complications.



STAKING

Prior to different phases of construction, surveyors will place wooden offset stakes and hubs to assist in the construction process. To prevent construction issues, we ask that property owners do not not remove stakes or hubs until project completion. The contractor will remove all staking at the end of the project.
