## **ORDINANCE NO. 2023-O-12**

## PROVISIONAL RETAIL LICENSE

The Village Board of the Village of Cleveland, Manitowoc County, WI pursuant to its police powers and Section 61.34 and Section 125.185, Wis. Stat., do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Village Board of Cleveland repeals and recreates Sec. 7-2-10 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Cleveland, WI as follows:

Sec. 7-2-10. – Granting of license; provisional retail license.

- (a) Opportunity shall be given by the governing body to any person to be heard for or against the granting of any license. Upon the approval of the applicant by the village board, the village clerk-treasurer shall issue to the applicant a license, upon payment by the applicant of the license fee to the village. The full license fee shall be charged for the whole or fraction of any year.
- (b) Provisional retail license.
  - (1) The village clerk-treasurer or the village clerk-treasurer's designee is authorized to issue a provisional retail license to a person who has applied for a Class "A", Class "B", "Class A", "Class B" or "Class C" license provided that, based upon the information contained in the application, the person meets the qualifications contained in Sec. 7-2-7 for issuance of licenses relating to alcohol beverages, as well as the qualifications for issuance of the retail license for which the application is submitted. A provisional retail license authorizes only the activities that the type of retail license applied for authorizes.
  - (2) A provisional retail license expires 60 days after its issuance or the Class "A", Class "B", "Class A", "Class B", or "Class C" license is issued to the holder or the village board denies the application, whichever is soonest. The village clerk-treasurer or the village clerk-treasurer's designee may revoke the license if he or she discovers that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application.
  - (3) Notwithstanding sub. (1) of this section, a provisional "Class B" license cannot be issued if the municipality's quota under Sec. 125.51 (4), Wis. Stats., prohibits the municipality from issuing a "Class B" license.
  - (4) Notwithstanding sub. (1) of this section, a provisional retail license shall only be issued if the premises to be licensed is approved for occupancy by the building inspection department and the fire department, and all taxes, assessments, or other financial claims of the village for the property and applicant are current.
  - (5) No person may hold more than one provisional retail license for each type of license applied for by the holder per year.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall become effective on the day of posting.
