First-installment taxes are collected at Village Hall. The Clerk's office will be open regular walk-in hours and the additional hours above to provide you more opportunity face-to-face service. You are also welcome to pay by mail or leave your payment in one of the drop boxes outside the Village Hall front door. The boxes will be checked daily, with the final check at 3:00 PM. Payments received after 3:00 PM will be dated the following day.

Receipts will be sent to property owners who provide a self-addressed stamped envelope. If your taxes are paid directly to us by an escrow company or bank, you can leave just the envelope with us and we will mail the receipt to you as confirmation of payment. You can also go online at the Manitowoc County website to print a copy of the tax bill or confirm the paid/unpaid status of your bill.

Property owners can provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with their tax payment and a receipt will be mailed. If your taxes are paid directly by an escrow company or bank, the envelope can be left with the Clerk's office.

- No envelope is required for owners that are licensing a dog at the same time as the tax payment. The tax receipt will be mailed with the dog license.

The tax payment deadline set by Wisconsin Statute is January 31. Payments by mail postmarked after January 31 will be considered delinquent and interest will accrue. If a property owner is too late to meet the postmark deadline, payments made in person or by drop box on or before 3:00 PM on February 7 will not be delinquent.
