## VILLAGE BOARD OF CLEVELAND, WISCONSIN SPECIAL MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2023 MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/ROLL CALL/AGENDA APPROVAL. Village President Jake Holzwart called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:03pm on Tuesday, November 7, 2023, in the Manitowoc County Training Room at Lakeshore Technical College, 1290 North Ave., Cleveland, Wisconsin.

- II. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION on a "Resolution Creating Tax Incremental District No. 2, Approving its Project Plan and Establishing its Boundaries." Phil Cosson of Ehlers & Associates reviewed the November 1, 2023, project plan for Tax Increment District No. 2 and answered questions. Motion Warosh/Paasch to adopt the Resolution Creating Tax Incremental District No. 2, Approving its Project Plan and Establishing its Boundaries; carried without negative vote. [Resolution No. 2023-R-18]
- III. FINAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE 2022 STREET PROJECTS: Beech St, Birch St, Cherry Hill Dr, Citrus Ln, and E Jefferson Ave. The Village Board discussed the Final Special Assessment Report for the Beech St, Birch St, E Jefferson Ave, Cherry Hill Dr, and Citrus Ln street reconstruction projects. After discussion, motion Paasch/Hoffman to adopt the Final Resolution Authorizing Public Improvement and Levying Special Assessments against Benefitted Property in Cleveland, Wisconsin; carried without negative vote, one abstention (Warosh). [Resolution No. 2023-R-19]
- IV. VILLAGE TRUSTEE VACANCY. The Board discussed without resolution whether to fill the vacancy. The matter was held over to the next meeting.
- V. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN UPDATE. The Board walked through the Capital Improvement Plan project tables and suggested changes in the Public Safety, Parks, and Buildings sections.
- VI. YEAR 2024 BUDGET, including 2023 TAX LEVY. Director Grunwald reviewed the draft levy limit worksheet, noting the Village was allowed a \$1508.00 increase in tax levy for 2024. Due to a drop in debt levy, the overall levy would decrease roughly 10%. The Village Board reviewed a draft general fund budget.
